2025 marks another milestone anniversary year. Ten years since we won marriage equality by popular vote. Ten years since the Gender Recognition Act. Ten years since the Children and Family Relationships Act. Ten years since the removal of the conscience clause.

These fundamental freedoms that some take for granted were hard won for our community. Liberties, not granted, but taken. As the civil rights activist Philip Randolph said "Freedom is never granted; it is won. Justice is never given; it is exacted."

We look back at the liberties we have taken, not just to celebrate them, but to remind ourselves how hard we fought to take them, and how hard we must be willing to fight to stop anyone taking those liberties away.

At a time when the liberties of our trans and non-binary and intersex family are being threatened and taken away, when Pride marches are being banned, and words like diversity, equity and inclusion are being demonised, we remind ourselves that at the root of Pride is liberty. Long before we were called Pride, we were called Liberation Day. The first Dublin Pride march in 1974 was organised by the Sexual Liberation Movement. We even start our march on the street named after 'The Liberator', Daniel O'Connell, whose 250th birthday falls this summer.

Taking liberties is what we do and will continue to do. We invite you to join us this June as we march in solidarity with our entire global LGBTQ+ family and send a clear message to the world: The liberties we have taken will not be taken back.





Pride Village is a free unticketed full day festival event supported by Dublin City council, the Department of Culture, Communications and Sport and our generous sponsors.

Children

Who are we?

In 2022, three organisations came together to form the LGBTQ+ Parenting Alliance. Equality for Children, Irish Gay Dads and LGBT Ireland had already been campaigning for children born to LGBTQ+ parents in Ireland, and the alliance was a way to strengthen their voices and collective goal. While the full commencement of the Children and Families Relationships Act (CFRA) in May 2020 was a step in the right direction, only a small number of children have benefitted from this leaislation. If you are an LGBTQ+ family who falls outside of the parameters of the CFRA, only the parent who is deemed to be the birth and/or biological parent can be listed on their child's birth certificate. While the full commencement of the Children and Families Relationships Act (CFRA) in May 2020 was a step in the right direction, only a small number of children have benefitted from this legislation.

IRISH GAY DADS



If you are an LGBTQ+ family who falls outside of the parameters of the CFRA, only the parent who is deemed to be the birth and/or biological parent can be listed on their child's birth certificate. This results in many avoidable issues for children as they grow up; medical treatment, school enrollments, foreign travel, tax/inheritance rights are just some of the areas that are needlessly complicated when one parent is viewed as a legal stranger to their child.

How can you help?

We need to put pressure on the current government to follow through on the promises to commence the already enacted "Health (Assisted Human Reproduction) Act 2024" and to urgently meet with advocacy groups to discuss the amendments needed to ensure all children are included. You can get involved through scanning the QR code to find ways in which you can support - sending emails, signing petitions or donating.
